

Making Your Natural Selection Journey Poster

In this final activity, you'll lead students through the previous seven lessons using a series of "bus stops" captured on a poster. The poster, when put together, looks like this:



As you can see, the image is divided into 12 pieces of paper. You'll need to post these together somewhere visible for the whole class before beginning the wrap-up. Putting the poster together is like making a small but very simple puzzle – you can use the image above as a reference point for where each piece of the poster should go.

Use tape to post the first four papers in a row. The next four papers go below that row, and the final four go under that row. Altogether, this will form the final 3 x 4 grid that comprises the poster!
