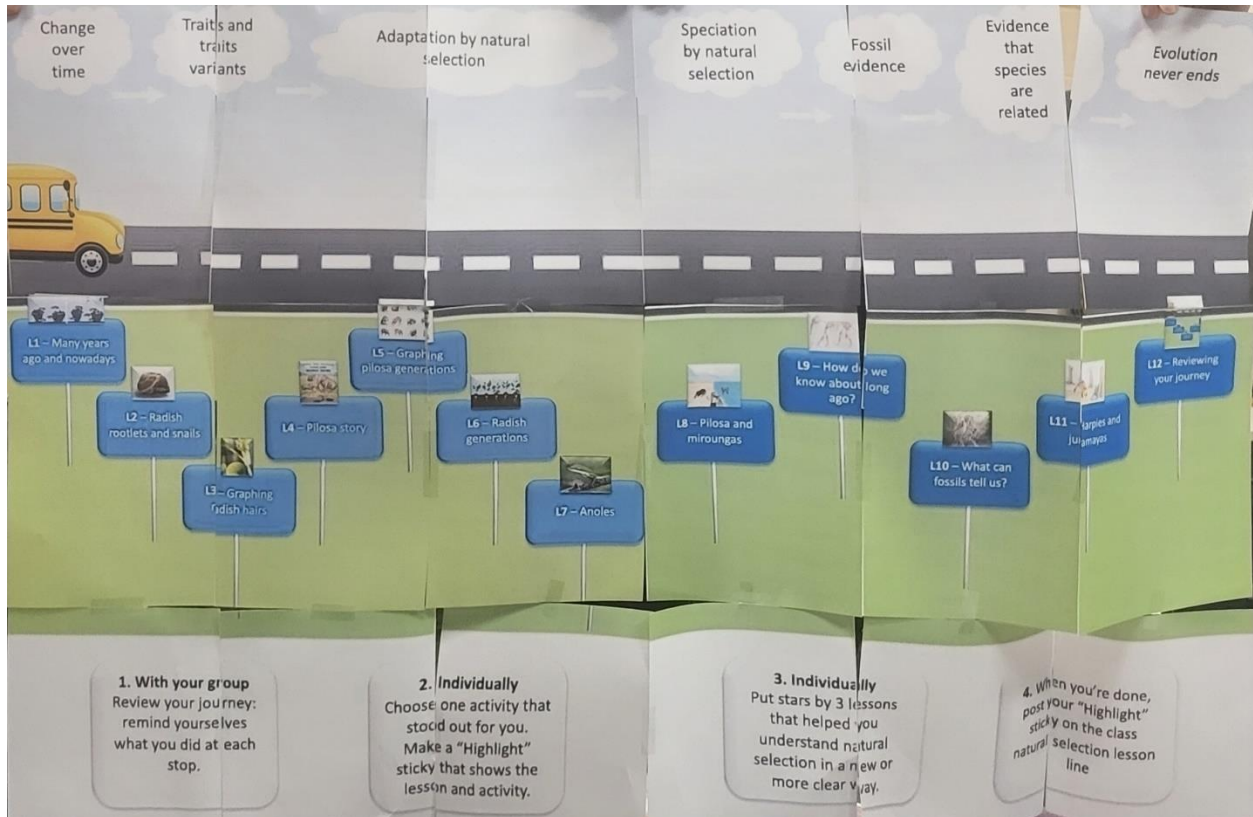


## Making Your Natural Selection Journey Poster

In this final lesson, you'll lead students through the entire curriculum using a series of "bus stops" captured on a poster. The poster, when put together, looks like this:



As you can see, the image is divided into 18 pieces of paper. You'll need to post these together somewhere visible for the whole class before the final portion of Lesson 12. Putting the poster together is like making a small but very simple puzzle – you can use the image above as a reference point for where each piece of the poster should go.

Use tape to post the first six papers from the stack in your L12 folder in a row. The next six papers go below that row, and the final six go under that row. Altogether, this will form the final 3 x 6 grid that comprises the poster!
